2023 Hall of Fame Inductees

Shane Thiele (Flinders)

Shane Thiele competed with the SAAL and the VAL from 1993 to 2015. Shane was nominated to the Bay Sheffield Hall of Fame on the back of his success in the open mile events at the Bay Sheffield Carnival. The wins included:

- Bay Sheffield Back Markers 1600m 1996 115m 4m 04.48s
- Bay Sheffield Select 1600m 1999 75m 4:06.30
- Bay Sheffield Select 1600m 2003 30m 4:07.12

He has podiumed 11 times at the event and made a return in 2018 to win the Bay Sheffield Fun Run!

Shane achieved considerable success in other SAAL events including being named Australian Pro Athlete of the Year. He also achieved success at the Stawell Easter Athletic Carnival, including winning both the mile & 2 mile race in 1999. He also won the Victory Handicap Mile in 1995 and the prestigious Herb Hedemann in 2006.

During his years with Flinders, Shane was an admired young man who proved to be a born leader and an inspiration to a generation of athletes, some who are still competing today. Shane is a credit to the League and has excelled both on and off the track.

Michael Buckler (McKinnon Parade)

Michael has been with The South Australian Athletic League since 1999 as an athlete, coach and administrator. His athletic career was between 1991 and 2004 making 2 finals at the Bay Sheffield in the Over 35s. In 2004 he took on the reins of coach at McKinnon Parade. His Bay Sheffield results include nine junior winners, four senior and four Over 35s.

Michael's nomination focussed on his unwavering commitment to track preparation and layout for the Bay Sheffield. Each year Michael puts in hundreds of hours working with council to put in place a track of superior quality despite its sandy composition. Michael has been significantly involved in track preparation and layout since 1998 and took on prime responsibility around 2013.

In addition to these Bay Sheffield duties Michael maintains his Coaching role and is the key person responsible for track preparation at all SAAL events. Michael is an outstanding individual and a worthy recipient of the award.

The Sports Council followed the practice of interstate clubs when a sash, presented by Mr. L.B. Starr, was awarded to the winner. These days this is common for all events.

Mr. B.J. Furnell was still officiating after almost 40 years on the Sports Council.

J.A. (Joe) Hunter, who had run second at Ararat the previous year from a long handicap, was only 17 years of age. He narrowly defeated Len Arnold who had dead-heated in 1917. Hunter was decorated by the Premier, Sir Henry Barwell. Joe modestly responded and paid a tribute to Mr. George Holder (Senior) with whom he had trained at Brighton. A protest lodged by Arnold was dismissed. Later Hunter was to win a Melbourne 1000 and become an Australian Sprint Champion.

Ern Wadham, who had won the Sheffield in the previous year, ran third in the Patawalonga Handicap. Later he was to become a well-known Norwood Football Club and S.A. National Football League Administrator. He was also Chief Judge at the 1972 Bay Sheffield Meeting.

W.E. (Bill) Dart, who won the Glenelg 75 yards Encourage Handicap off 9.25 yards in 7.4 seconds (first prize 10 pounds) was still running at Bay Meetings in the late 1940s.

Hal Thomas capped his most successful year in professional running when at 38 years of age he clearly won the Bay Sheffield from a 4.5 metres handicap on Colley Reserve on Friday, December 28, 1973. This was the first year the Sheffield was conducted in the recently constructed Colley Reserve "Bowl". More than 3000 people saw Thomas (4.5) defeat Gary Hancock (8¾) and Frank McHugh (9½) in the good time of 12.3 seconds.

In the 1973 Glenelg Sprint, Craig Marriot (6) was successful from Mort Daly (7.25) and R.K. (Klynton) Kitto (7). This was to be Craig Marriott's first of three great wins in this sprint event.

The Patawalonga Handicap was extended to 800 metres because it was found to be unsafe to run the traditional 400m event in the re-constructed amphitheatre.

Former Olympian, Chris Fisher, produced an amazing performance to win the 800 metres event from scratch in the great time of one minute 57 seconds. Fisher is the only competitor to win this event from scratch and in his brief but most successful professional running career, he showed this section of the sport the wonderful ability he had previously displayed as a sub-four minute miler as an amateur.

In a 120 metres Qualifying Handicap included in the programme, Paul Dawe (2½) won from H. Devries (4) with Lindsay Caspers (6) in third place.

The South Australian Sprint Championship (120 metres) conducted at this meeting was won by Hal Thomas from John Lovell and Brendon Wilson. Time 12.4 seconds.

JIM TRAVERS

(written by 1963 Bay Sheffield winner, Greg Adams)

Jim Travers was a member of a very prominent Whyalla sporting family and became associated with the SA Athletic League through Whyalla Gift Carnivals that commenced in the 1940s. In 1944, he won the 440 yards Patawalonga Handicap in a record equalling 48.25 secs. He won the race for the second time in 1947.

He became League handicapper in the early 1950s and held the position until 1965 when he became League President and Vice-President of the inaugural Australian National Athletic Council, a position he held until 1973. Jim Travers became President when the League was at one of its lowest points when Amateur Athletics, by virtue of the influence of its President, attempted to take control of all athletics in the state. Jim and a small group worked tirelessly to retain the League and restore its rightful role in the State's Sporting Calendar.

Following his passing at a relatively young age, it was decided that the 120m Restricted race at this Carnival would be named after him.


