Not running up to PB shape but should be competitive in the semis.

Samuel Blyzno21Debbie MeichFlagstaff Hill SA10.75mWon the 2021 Mt Gambier Gift (12.56s off 12.25m). He was 2nd at Crystal Brook in January 2022 (12.31soff 12.0m). At Stawell 2023 Sam ran 2nd in the 200m final running 20.09s off 17m. He opened theseason with a 5th place in the Marion 120m 8/10/2023, (12.46s off 10.75m). Last start at Waverley10/12/2023, he only ran 4th in his heat (11.13s off 6.75m). Hard to gauge where he is at, but based onMarion, he is a serious contender for a final spot.

10.0m). Didn't make the Port Adelaide 100m final but did run 3rd in the 60m (6.60s off 5.5m). One of
4 athletes in the double-digit handicap range who will by vying for a coveted spot in the final.

Kyle Briggs19Paul YoungOne Tree Hill SA6.00mPromising debut at Marion running 2nd in the Novice 120m however has suffered a string of injuries
that have interrupted his preparation. Has a 100m PB of 10.95s as a 17yo & ran 7.05s for 60m last
month. Lacks the race condition but could go OK in the 120m Restricted.

Javon Brijmahon18Andrew ChandlerSomerton Park SA4.75mWon the 2021 Bay Sheffield (12.34s off 8.75m). Back in the marks and struggling to get past a heat.Ran 3rd in his heat of the Brighton 100m in 11.32s off 4.0m and 4th in his heat at PreBay (13.33s off4.75m). Still eligible for the under 18s event which is his best chance for a final.

Kevin Brittain34Self TrainedGeelong VIC9.50mDual Stawell Gift finalist in his heyday. Won the Mt Gambier 70m (7.71s off 6.25m) 25/11/2023. Backed
up with 3rd in the Mt Gambier 120m Gift (12.90s off 9.25m). Only managed 6th in his Waverley 100m
semi-final (10.80s off 7.75m). Mt Gambier run suggests he will be competitive.

Matt Burleigh27Todd IrelandCroydon Hills VIC8.75mWell performed pro runner over distances up to 400m. A Bay Sheffield finalist (5th) in 2018 off 10.00m.Won the Hastings Gift in 2021 (12.70s off 9.25m) before running 12.28s (9.75m) in his heat at Stawell.Just missed the Stawell final that year. Recent form hasn't been at the 2021 level – only managed 3rdin his heat of the Terang 12m Gift (13.04s off 8.25m).

Oliver Callahan26Debbie MeichAdelaide SA7.00mWon the Henley Gift back in 2016 as a 16yo (12.64s off 7.5m). 2019 Bay Sheffield finalist (5th off 6.75min 12.47s). Ran a 100m PB off 10.84s in March 2022. Has raced sparingly but appears to be in goodform, running 10.93s (+1.3) on 21/10/2023 at ASA interclub, and 3rd in the Port Adelaide 100m (10.24soff 5.75m). If he runs to PB shape, he's a chance to be in his second Bay Sheff final.

Ryan Camille34Nick FiedlerWheelers Hill VIC9.25mAnother seasoned pro with numerous big gift finals to his name including 6th in the 2018 Bay Sheffieldoff 9.75m. He won the Bay Sheffield Restricted in 2012. Last time he placed in a Gift was 3rd at Euroain March 2022 (12.44s off 10.50m). Only ran 3rd in his Waverley Gift heat (11.04s off 7.50m)10/12/2023. Not quite in the same form he was in 2018.9.25m

Alexander Chan26Andrew BeckSomerton Park SA6.50mSecond year athletewho burst on the scene last year with an impressive win in the Novice 70m atBrighton. Won his first 120mGift at Kensington 15/10/2023 (12.5 off 6.50m). Ran 2nd in the KeithPatching Sprint (7.71s off 3.75m). Last start he was 4th in the PreBay 120m Gift (12.52s off 6.00m).Goes forward 0.50mFreBay mark – puts him in contention for a final spot.

Joe Chigwidden18Charles SheffieldSomerton Park SA9.50mWon the Under 18 Boy's Bay Sheffield in 2021 but is struggling for form this season. Only ran 5th in his
heat in 11.51s off 7.75m in the Brighton 100m 14/12/2023 and 4th in his heat at PreBay (13.41s off
9.25m). Prefer in the Restricted 120m.

Jesse Cordoma28Paul YoungKurralta Park SA8.25m2022 Bay Sheffield finalist, his biggest wins have come interstate with the 2019 Bunbury Gift (WA) and2021 Geelong 100m Gift. Recently finished 3rd in the Brighton 100m Final 14/12/2023 (10.81s off6.75m). Ran OK at PreBay just missing the final (3rd in his semi-final off 8.00m in 12.59s). He has hadissues with his knee this season but is getting better & more confident with every run.

Hayden Crowe19Paul YoungBurrungala SA5.75m2021 Bay Sheffield finalist (6.50m) then won the Reynella 120m Gift in January 2022 off 6.0m.Struggled with injury this season, only managed 4th in his heat at Brighton (11.12s off 4.75m). Onlymanaged 13.12s off 5.75m in his heat at PreBay.

Anjo Custodio23Paul YoungIngle Farm SA7.50mNovice athlete has run second in two novice 70m races this season at Flinders & Brighton (8.05s off
4.0m). Ran 2nd in his heat of the Brighton 100m in 11.29s off 5.75m and 5th in his heat at PreBay (13.20s
off 7.00m) Prefer in the 120m Restricted on Day One.7.50m

Owen de Vries22Shane McKenzieRingwood East VIC8.00mNovice athlete who was a fair way back at Gifts in Terang - 120m (14.15s off 7.0m) and Waverley-100m (12.32s off 5.75m). Prefer his chances on Day One.

Max Disbury17Andrew ChandlerSomerton Park SA7.75mWon the Under 18's 300m at Marion but hasn't featured much in the shorter events. Ran 4th in his heat
of the Brighton 100m in 11.78s off 6.0m. Prefer in the Under 18's 120m.7.75m

Jack Doney26Angus BrockSt Peters SA5.75mVery good A grade sprinter in the amateur ranks with a 100m PB of 10.70s (W: +1.8) in March 2023.He won the Camden 120m in February 2023 and most recently won the Brighton 100m Gift14/12/2023 (10.62s off 4.75m). Then ran 4th in the Keith Patching 70m Sprint, which meant he had 5races on the night. A two-week taper post Brighton & he will be cherry ripe for this.

Benjamin Driver19Self TrainedAberfoyle Park SA7.25mNovice athlete with little form to go on. Ran 5th in his heat of the PreBay Gift (13.58s off 7.00m) about8m away from the winner of the heat. Can't see him getting past the heat stage.

John Evans26Paul YoungKurralta Park SA8.25mWell performed athlete including wins in the Port Adelaide, Brighton & Kensington Gifts in 2016/2017.Has not won a Gift since Kensington although he has been competitive on occasions making finals in
some of the VAL carnivals. Ran 3rd in his heat of the Brighton 100m off 7.00m in 10.95s, just missing
the final. Yet to make the Bay final and form suggests he will miss again.

James Forrest24Darren KynastonWarner QLD9.50mFormerly from SA, now residing in Queensland. Won a minor 120m race in Ipswich in 2022, but hasn't
made a final in races in the VAL or SAAL. Hasn't got past a heat this season and only ran 11.67s for the
100m in a recent AQ event. Prefer on Day One.9.50m

Cailen Hejka22Dylan Hicks/Gaby PhilisHappy Valley SA5.50mKicked off his career in 2021 with a victory in the Marion Novice 120m. Made the final of the BaySheffield in his first season (4th in 12.53s off 6.75m). Last year he won the PreBay 120m Gift at ColleyReserve (12.26s off 6.75m) before running 2nd in the Bay Sheffield (12.31s off 6.75m). Producedanother solid performance in the PreBay 120m on 17/12/2023 finishing 3rd (12.48s off 5.25m).Goes into the event in great form and could make a third consecutive final.

Hugh Hoffman22Todd IrelandBallarat VIC9.25mOne of the few interstate athletes coming to the Bay with winning form after a superb victory in the
Waverley 100m 10/12/2023 (10.45s off 7.50m). A week earlier he was 3rd in the Terang Gift (12.53s off
9.25). He gets a bonus for Stawell where his mark is 10.0m. So, this becomes a free hit for him. Unlikely
to win off 9.25m but this is the perfect dress rehearsal for his tilt at the 2024 Stawell Gift.

Hamish Hopkins19Shane McKenzieWarranwood VIC8.00mSecond year novice who ran 3rd in the Bill Howard 100m Restricted at Stawell, earlier this year (10.71soff 10.00m). Only managed 4th in his heat of the Waverley 100m Gift 10/12/2023 (11.22s off 5.75m).Made the 70m semis, so best chances lie with the events on Day One.

Harrison Hunt24Dylan Hicks/Gaby PhilisSeacombe Gardens SA2.50mThe most successful Bay Sheffield man at the meet with a victory in 2018 (12.22s off 3.75m) and second
in 2017 and 2021 (12.38s off 3.25m). Easily won the 2019 Warrnambool Gift off the same mark he has
here (12.38s off 2.50m). Only 1.25m back from the mark he won off as an 18yo and clearly improved
since then. Ran 4th in the Brighton 100m (10.93s off 2.0m). Might get squeezed out of contention for
the final. Should go well in the backmarkers 120m invitation, which he won last year.

Darcy Ireland21Todd IrelandWarrandyte South VIC9.50mWon the Bill Howard 100m Restricted at Stawell in 2019 (10.39s off 11.75m). Won the 2020 Rye 70mand the Stawell 400m frontmarkers this year.Last 120m Gift he contested was Terang 03/12/2023(14.07s off 9.00m). No Gift form of note.

Jake Ireland23Todd IrelandWarrandyte South VIC5.00mWon the Bay Sheffield 120m Restricted in 2018, at his first visit to Colley Reserve. Massive WOW factor
when he scorched the earth, running 12.01sec off 8.75m to win the 2021 Wangaratta Gift. Went back
to 6.25m and ran a brilliant race to snaffle 5th in the 2021 Stawell Gift final (12.33s off 6.25m). Ran 4th
in the 2022 Bay Sheffield (12.45s off 450m). Unfortunately, Jake suffered an injury at Terang 3/12/2023
and got a 14-day holiday from the stewards. Might lack race fitness for this.

Blake Jones22Debbie MeichWest Beach SA8.50mHas a very respectable 400mPB of 48.07s (4/3/2023). Won the 2022 Camden 120m in February
(12.64s off 8.25m). Off the back of a 200m PB of 22.04s, he came into the carnival in decent shape
winning the Bay Sheffield 70m off 6.25m. Injured at Marion he has taken a while to get back on the
track. Struggled at PreBay (5th in his heat in 12.86s off 8.25m).

Kristerfer Kardakovski32Self TrainedEpping VIC11.00mProlific Gift finalist, his last win was the 2019 Geelong 100m Gift (10.59s off 9.25m). Has scratched alot in the last 12 months due to niggling injuries. He was 6th in the Warrnambool Gift 2/12/2023,(12.84s off 11.25m) but only ran the 70m at Waverley. Comes back to the 11.0m limit so meets manyof his fellow Vics worse off. Prefer in the 70m on Day One.

Harrison Kerr24Nick FiedlerBayswater North VIC2.75mEnjoyed a successful trip to the Bay in 2016 winning the 120m Restricted (12.20s off 9.50m) 2nd in the
70m and making the Bay Sheff final. Comprehensively won the 2022 Stawell Gift (11.85s off 9.25m).
Ran well in the Bay Sheffield backmarkers last year (2nd) and has been in good form off tight marks in
the VAL. Ran 2nd in the Waverley 70m 10/12/2023. Ran 8th in the Waverley 100m semi-final (11.11s off
2.0m). Running well - has a chance in the 70m and a lane in the backmarkers.

Olufemi Komolafe19Paul YoungBurnside SA6.50mOpened the season with a terrific win in the Marion 120m Novice (12.9 off 6.0m). Ran 4th in the
Burnside 120m Gift final (12.7 off 6.50m). Ran 8th in the Brighton 100m Gift final 14/12/2023 (10.94s
off 5.50m). Promising athlete who should go well in the Restricted 120m on Day One.

Harry Kowal19Peter BurdettWynn Vale SA10.50mWon the 120m Restricted & Under 18 Boys 120m (13.12s off 8.25m) double at the 2020 Bay Sheffield
carnival. Much taller and stronger now days, he ran OK at PreBay finishing 4th in his heat (12.71s off
10.50m). Probably not ready for this but has got ability so one to watch for the future.

Nicholas Krznaric28Peter BurdettAdelaide SA11.00mBurst on the scene in 2016, impressively winning the 70m Novice (7.71s off 5.50m) at the PreBay
carnival. Hasn't done a lot since making the occasional final. Best recent 120m gift performance would
be his 5th place at PreBay 17/12/2023 (12.67s off 11.75m). Mark comes back to the limit so unlikely to
be in contention for the final.

Jack Lacey25Nick FiedlerBayswater North VIC8.75mWon the 2015 Junior Bay Sheffield U/18s (13.11s off 8.0m). Won the 2016 Bendigo Black Opal 400m(44.99s off 34m). Took some time off and returned in 2021. Ran 2nd in the Stawell 70m this year. Hassome good form over the Gift distance and will be competitive in the semis.

Sami Latu21Nick FiedlerWantirna South VIC6.00mMaking his pro debut at the Bay Sheffield. Nunawading amateur athlete he ran 11.83s for 100m11/3/2023. Prefer in the 120m Restricted on Day one.

Steven Lester32Shane McKenzieRingwood VIC11.00mSecond year athlete yet to make a mark in gift running, he was unplaced in his heats of the 100m at
both Geelong (11.46s off 7.50m) and Waverley (11.30s off 8.25m). Prefer in events on Day One.

Anthony Lieu25Debbie MeichWest Brunswick VIC8.00mSecond year athlete, formerly from SA, now in Victoria.Yet to make it out of a heat, he was unplacedin heats at Geelong (12.17s off 5.0m) and Waverley (11.94s off 5.25m).Prefer in events on Day One.

Patrick Martin28Peter O'DwyerNerrina VIC8.25mBallarat lad whose biggest win to date was the Stawell Backmarkers 400m this year (46.02s off 21m).Ran a decent time in the 2022 Stawell Gift heat (12.41s off 8.25m) before recording 12.72s in the semi-final. Ran 3rd in the Shepparton Gift in March (12.52s off 8.0m). He was 8th in the Geelong 100m Giftfinal 18/11/2023 (10.79s off 6.35m). Goes forward 0.75m on his VAL mark. If he reproduces his 2022Stawell Gift form, he is a huge chance for the final.

Thomas McClure23Andrew BeckRose Green SA6.25mWinner of the Crystal Brook Gift in his only second start, smashing the event target time (12.40s) with
a blistering 12.25s off 6.25m. Previous week he could only manage 4th place in the Burnside 120m Gift
semi-final (12.73s off 6.00m). Has only competed at Port Adelaide since. Hard to beat based on his
Crystal Brook run.

Joseph McKinnon20Debbie MeichMarino SA10.00mHas had an outstanding season to date, winning four races over 4 different distances the Marion 300m,Flinders 200m, the Port Adelaide 100m Gift (10.15s off 9.50m) and the PreBay 120m Gift (12.31s off10.00m). Has winning form and would be in the top 3 chances.

Michael Moschou19Paul YoungFlinders Park SA2.00mOne of the most exciting talents to emerge from the proscene in decades. Brilliant winner of the 2022Bay Sheff (12.21s off 5.25m).He became the first man to win the 120m Restricted/120m Bay Sheffieldsince Darren Kappler in 1985.Two weeks ago, he became only the third athlete to win the prestigiousKeith Patching 70m Sprint from behind 3.0m (7.67s off 2.50m) joining Todd Bateman (2.50m in 2008)and Harrison Hunt (2.25m in 2018).This season he ran 4 consecutive personal bests over 60m (6.83s),100m (10.69s), 200m (21.30s) & 400m (48.45s).Took a hefty pull in the marks after the Bay Sheffieldbut is gradually getting better to where he can be in the mix.

Liam Moss26Rick TreleavenGlen Osmond SA4.50mOne of the best in SA with very good 100m/200m PB's of 10.59s/21.38s. Three-time Bay Sheffieldfinalist in 2016, 2018 (3rd) and 2019 (4th off 4.25m in 12.43s). Made the Terang Gift final (4th off 4.50min He only managed 5th in his heat of the PreBay 120m Gift (12.73s off 4.50m). Will be there aboutsand, with improvement, a fourth Bay final is not out of the question.

Aidan Murphy20Dylan Hicks/Gaby PhilisSefton Park SA1.75mSouth Australian state100m & 200m record holder with elite level times of 10.33s & 20.41s. Competedin the 2023 World Championships in Budapest running20.9s in the 200m. Ran with the SAAL as ajunior but hasn't yet as a senior athlete. Ran 2nd in the 2022 Burnie Gift (12.20s off 2.0m). Ran 20.95srecently at an ASA competition. Might lack race conditioning but has the PB's to suggest he could dosome damage off this mark.

Noah Nakagawa18Daniel SammutTerrigal NSW6.00mNovice athlete made his debut at Newcastle 17/12/2023. Nice run first up -4^{th} in his 100m heat (11.0s off 5.0m). Won his heat of the 300m & finished 4^{th} in the final (35.83s off 10.0m). Clearly has some talent and won't be long before he is competitive in the VAL Gifts.

Fejiro Omuvwie31Darren KynastonBahrs Scrub QLD2.50mOne of the class interstaters in the field with a legal 100m PB of 10.44s. Won the 2018 WarrnamboolGift off 5.0m then took out the prestigious 2020 Maryborough Gift (12.35s off 3.50m). Ran 5th in the2021 Ballarat Gift (12.48s off 1.75m). Suffered a debilitating quad muscle injury last year which he isyet to recover from. Last few 100m starts he hasn't broken 11sec. Unlikely to get past the heat.

Tapasu Paea23Scott RowsellKings Park SA6.75mLightning off the mark he has made several finals over 70m including two wins at Castlemaine 2 years
apart – in 2021 he ran 7.57s off 3.50m & in 2023 (7.64s off 3.50m). He was 7th in the Shepparton Gift
in March (12.72s off 6.75m). Did not make the final of either Geelong 100m (11.14s off 5.50m) nor
Waverley 100m (10.77s off 5.50m. Should go well in the 70m on Day One.

Michael Papanotis20Charles SheffieldWest Lakes SA10.50mWon the Kensington Gift as a 15yo off 14.75m in 12.44sec. Ran 3rd in his heat of the Brighton 100m(11.10s off 8.75m) & 4th in a heat of the Port Adelaide 100m (10.71s off 8.75m). Prefer in events on

Ran OK at Mortlake – 2nd in his 120m Gift heat off 10.0m in 13.25s. Thatwas his last run over the distance. Only contested the 70m at Waverley. Prefer in the Over 35's.

Xavier Poole19Frank McHughAberfoyle Park SA10.75mProlific sash winner with 14 and still only 19yo. Won the Victor Harbor 120m Gift in March 2022 (13.04soff 10.75m) and commenced the 2022/2023 season off 10.50m. Won the 60m at Port Adelaide off amark and in a time to suggest he would have gone very close to winning the 100m the same day. Wasa close 2nd to training partner Hayden Rothe at Mt Gambier. Goes forward 0.25m and if he is fit andcapable of getting up the track, he has a massive chance.

Daniel Quattrone21Chris ViPreston VIC9.50mBetter known as a 300/400 athlete his last win was the 2022 Hastings 300m (34.88s off 34m). He also
won the 2021 Wangaratta 400m. Yet to make a mark over 120m, he ran 6th in his 2023 Stawell Gift heat
(12.92s off 9.50m). Hasn't contested a 120m race this season, now coached by 2021 Bay Sheff finalist
Chris Vi so if he gets to the start line, it will be interesting to see how he goes.9.50m

Ran 5th in his Macksville Gift semi-final (13.26s off 6.75m). Son of the great Paul Singletonwho is the only man to run 1st (1984) 2nd (1983) & 3rd (1995) in the Stawell Gift. Should be in the BaySheff semis, but best chance of a final is on Day One.

Max Tracey25Frank McHughAtlanta, Georgia USA7.00mAn American baseballer from Atlanta Georgia, he only arrived back in Australia a few weeks ago.Immediately had an impact with a brilliant 2nd place in the PreBay 120m Gift (12.36s off 7.50m). Heran in last year's race but appears to be in better shape this time round. He won the Barossa 120mtowards the end of last season before going back to the USA to play baseball. Definitely a chance forthe final.

Mitchell Tucker28David GrossWarradale SA10.75mWon the 2016 PreBay Gift at Colley Reserve (12.40s off 8.00m) & made numerous finals since but
hasn't been able to add to his 120m gift tally. Last win was the Flinders 200m in 2020. Eye catching run
at Brighton 14/12/2023 where he won his heat (10.78s) easily before losing 3m in the final (11.10s off
9.0m). Looked the winner of the PreBay Gift after he ran 12.31s in the semis before clearly breaking
and losing 1m. Ended up last in 12.74s. Has catapulted into calculations off the back of the last 2 starts.
One of the top 5 contenders.
